- ◆ Family Registration Forms must be completed and mailed along with your check or money order made payable to MHEA. Facilities will be available on a “first come-first served” basis, therefore, we will not be able to accept reservations via internet or email. No refunds will be given after the **registration deadline of October 6.**
- ◆ Camp Dixon allows your choice of various meal preparations. Two **Meal Package** options are offered which may be purchased for the weekend that includes supper on Thursday, 3 meals on Friday and 3 meals on Saturday **OR** supper on Friday, and 3 meals on Saturday. Campers, you may prepare your own meals or purchase a Meal Package.

LODGING: Monitor the website, WWW.MHEA.NET, for lodging availability.

- ◆ The **motel-style rooms** have one double bed. Small children may sleep in bedrolls on the floor. The upstairs rooms have AC and community baths. The downstairs rooms have AC and a private bath.
- ◆ The **pond-side cabins** have bunk beds and sleep up to eight. Each have heat/AC and private baths. Two handicapped facilities are also available. These sleep five with two double beds and a cot.
- ◆ **Campsites** are available with or without hook-ups. Bathhouses are also available.
- ◆ You will need to bring your own soaps, linens, bath towels, etc. for each family member.
- ◆ The 1-Mile Fun Run and 5K Race held on Saturday morning is for all ages.

From Philadelphia: Stay on Hwy 15 South until you pass Philadelphia. Go through the Hwy 15 & 16 intersection. Traveling south take the next right onto Hwy 21, toward Sebastopol. Stay on Hwy 21 past the Neshoba County Fairgrounds until you come to Dixon. Begin looking for an old, white, wooden church building. At the church, turn left and go 1½ miles. Take a right at the Camp Dixon sign. The campground is ½ mile down the road.

From Forest: Take the Forest exit off I-20. You will then be on Hwy 35. Stay on this road through Forest until you pass the Pizza Hut. Take a right onto Hwy 21. Stay on Hwy 21 until you come to Dixon. Begin looking for an old, white, wooden church building on the left. At the church, turn right and go 1½ miles. Take a right at the Camp Dixon sign. The campground is ½ mile down the road.

From Newton/Decatur: Take the Decatur exit off I-20. Stay on Hwy 15, going through Decatur and past Union. At the Neshoba exit a large sign reads “Mississippi State Church of God Campground”. Turn left. At the next Camp Dixon sign make a left turn at the Neshoba Baptist Church. Follow this road approximately 5 to 6 miles, then turn left at the next Camp Dixon sign. The campground is ½ mile down the road.
